Enrollment Agreement

Tuition and expenses: A \$700 deposit must accompany this application. The deposit is 50% refundable until March 1 and is non-refundable after that date. **The full balance is due April 1.** Full payment is required for all applications sent after April 1. If after April 1 you find that your child cannot attend camp, we will do our best to refund tuition when we are able to replace your reserved space with a new enrollment. But because we hire staff and purchase horses, equipment and supplies based on anticipated enrollment, tuition is otherwise neither refundable nor pro-rated after April 1.

Tuition includes room and board, 24-hour supervision, laundry, horseback riding, qualified instruction, craft supplies and a camp t-shirt. **Tuition does not include** medical insurance; riding helmet; personal items such as toiletries, photographs, stationery, stamps, souvenirs or transportation between camp and train, plane or bus.

Policies: New Meadow is a small, family-run camp and is not equipped to support children with special needs — physical or emotional. The camp reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose presence and/or behavior, in the judgment of the director, is detrimental to the camp, your child or the other children in attendance. This includes misconduct and/or willful endangerment to herself or others, and a no tolerance policy toward the use of drugs and/or alcohol. **Once a camper arrives at camp, no refunds will be made for any reason, no matter whether she later withdraws or is asked to leave.**

Arrival and departure: Campers are asked to arrive between 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. on their first day of camp. On the last day of camp, pickup is before noon unless other arrangements are made with the director. **There are no refunds for campers who arrive after their session begins or leave before it ends.**

Application forms: In addition to the camp application, **two copies of a completed health history and one copy of a liability form are required for our files.** Each of these forms can be downloaded from links on the Signup page at www.newmeadowcamp.com. Every camper and counselor is required to have a medical examination within a year prior to arrival at camp. Both copies of the health history must be signed by the examining physician. These forms **must be received at our Ashford Farm address before June 1.**

What to bring: Comfortable clothes are best. Each article — especially socks — should be plainly marked with the owner's full name. We recommend that each girl post a list of contents inside the top of her footlocker (see the Essentials page of this application). Footlockers must fit under a camp cot, approximately 30" x 15.5" x 12". A duffel bag or suitcase is also suitable. Please do not send more than is listed — we feel from past experience that this is more than enough. Bunkhouse storage space is limited and items that do not fit in your child's footlocker will be sent home. **Trunks should be sent via UPS in time to arrive at New Meadow one week before the start of camp.**

Important notes

- Parents' Day will be Saturday, July 17.
- The camp will supply all tack, saddle pads, horse grooming supplies and tack cleaning supplies. Please do not bring a tack trunk.
- If you would like to bring your own horse to camp, please contact Caroline for stall availability and other information. Board is \$125 per week and a negative coggins is required.
- Remember that this is a horse farm — do not send any designer clothes. Riding attire, however, should be appropriate for horse shows.
- All clothing must be labeled with the camper's name — either taped or marked in black laundry marker — including clothes worn to the camp.
- Do not bring any valuables (*i.e.*, nice watches, jewelry, computers).
- All cell phones must be handed in to the director and will be returned when campers leave the farm. Phone calls to campers are permitted on birthdays and for true emergencies.
